

FS-ISAC Survey Pre-announcement: Survey on IE7 Upgrade via AutoUpdate / WSUS

An FS-ISAC member has requested member participation in a survey on the Internet Explorer 7 Upgrade via AutoUpdate / Windows Server Update Services (WSUS). Primary Points of Contact will be the only persons receiving the invite. We ask that they complete the survey, or forward the invite to the appropriate person at their institution to complete. The FS-ISAC hopes that the one-invitation-per-institution approach will increase the quality of the data we receive, but we rely on POCs to take an active role in the survey process.

The purpose of this survey is to determine the approach firms are taking with regard to the Internet Explorer 7 Upgrade via AutoUpdate or via Windows Server Update Services (WSUS). On February 12, 2008 Microsoft will upgrade machines running Internet Explorer 6 to Windows Internet Explorer 7, if those machines are configured to auto-approve updates through AutoUpdate or WSUS. The survey will be sent to FS-ISAC Basic, Core, Standard, Premier, Gold and Platinum member institution Points of Contact. The survey will be open from Wednesday, February 6, 2008 to noon EST on Monday, February 11, 2008. Your input will be anonymous. The invitation will be sent out today, February 6, 2008.
