Securities Industry Risk Group (SIRG) EMEA Email List Created

Based on member feedback, the Securities Industry Risk Group (SIRG) - Europe Middle East and Africa (EMEA) email distribution list was created to provide an information sharing forum for FS-ISAC member firms. Members included in this group are securities/investment industry (including asset managers, broker dealers, hedge funds, private equity firms) based in the EMEA region who want to share information with other members in the region. This email distribution list will allow members in the EMEA region to gain a more hands-on experience with their FS-ISAC membership and have a new outlet for information sharing related to cyber and physical threats and regulatory cybercompliance. Members of this group will also be included in the FS-ISAC SIRG mailing list to enable them to communicate with other members in the SIRG and to receive SIRG materials like newsletters, invites to SIRG meetings and access to material in the SIRG folder on the Portal.

The FS-ISAC Public-Private Partnerships team this year established the Critical Infrastructure Collaboration Working Group (CICWG), intended to serve as a highly trusted, real-time information exchange among ISACs with significant reach to

ISAC Analysis Team Updates

Oracle Critical Patches

Oracle released its July Critical Patch Update (CPU) last week fixing 308 vulnerabilities. This Critical Patch Update provides fixes for products families including: Oracle Database Server, Oracle Enterprise Manager, Oracle Fusion Middleware, Oracle Hyperion, Oracle E-Business Suite, Oracle Industry Applications (communications, retail and hospitality), Oracle Primavera, Oracle Sun Products, Oracle Java SE and Oracle MySQL. 136 of the issues addressed by the security patches can be exploited remotely without authentication. 27 out of the 308 vulnerabilities addressed by Oracle were classified as critical flaws rated with a CVSS base score between 9.0 and 10.0. The most severe issues addressed by the critical patch updates are CVE-2017-10137, CVE-2017-10202, CVE-2015-3253, CVE-2017-5689 and CVE-2016-4436.

This has also improved FS-ISAC's information exchange with our sector dependencies and has allowed us to share such information within our membership.

Alternative Investor Council (AIC) Summary


The Alternative Investors Council (AIC) held a meeting in NYC at Two Sigma, an FS-ISAC member firm, on July 20. The members participated in a presentation from Flashpoint and received an overview by Greg Gist and Barry Richards on North East First. The AIC consists of 90 members representing 57 firms. Of those firms, 38 are hedge funds, nine are private equity firms and 10 are other alternative investment firms.

Trickbot Starts Targeting US Financial Institutions

IBM Trusteer researchers report rising TrickBot campaigns with configurations targeting banks in various English-speaking geographies. TrickBot's operators continue to focus on business banking, aiming for larger bounties in each attack. It has been the most active banking Trojan in terms of geographical scope in 2017. TrickBot's operators typically test the waters in different regions and then expand the attack target list. TrickBot quickly spreads to new locales and deploys redirection attacks. TrickBot is good at varying the types of files and attachments utilized in order to evade automated detection. FS-ISAC members may log into the member Portal for additional information.
