Carolyn McInerney, Assistant Vice President, Business Continuity at Navy Federal Credit Union is retiring effective June 2012. Carolyn served on the Board of FS-ISAC, and on a number of committees including the Business Resilience Committee. In addition, she was Co-Chair of the NCR FIRST regional coalition. Please join us in thanking her for her years of service and congratulating on her retirement.

In other news, the FS-ISAC is engaged in a cross-sector initiative to mitigate botnets. The primary focus of the Joint ISAC BOTNET Mitigation Process Working Group is to establish an automated mechanism via the FS-ISAC for Financial Sector entities to share information about malware (BOTS) they have identified as actively conducting malicious activity or are part of a BOTNET with key BOTNET Mitigation Stakeholder's identified during the course of this year, which include internet service providers, cloud providers, commercial broadband providers, Anti-Virus companies, security vendors or similar entities so that that provider can notify the owner of the infected PC and have that owner attempt to remediate that PC. These efforts and other industry Botnet mitigation efforts will be recognized in a ceremony at the White House later this month.

And as a result of Operation B71, the Zeus, Spyeye, ICE IX takedown in March 2012, spam emails with the NACHA brand have decreased from 11 million per day to under 1 million. Chalk one up for the good guys!

FS-ISAC will also be using the exercise to drill its incident operations by engaging the Threat Intelligence Committee, the Business Resilience Committee, the FS-ISAC SOC, NCCIC Liaisons and the Cyber UCG. Threat Indicators Module Now Available On Portal

The FS-ISAC is pleased to announce the availability of the Critical Infrastructure Key Resources (CIKR) Threat Indicators Module on the Member Portal. The CIKR Threat Module replaces multiple Comma Separated Value (CSV) files that have been published in the past, and provides a single, central repository containing up-to-date threat indicators collected from various sources, including: • FS-ISAC Member Submissions • Multi-State ISAC • Cyber Information Sharing and Collaboration Program (CISCP) • Government Information Sharing Framework (GISF) • Government Agencies and • US-CERT. Records in the CIKR Threat Indicators Module are classified FS-ISAC Red, FS-ISAC Yellow, FS-ISAC Green or FS-ISAC White according to the Traffic Light Protocol. FS-ISAC members can run custom queries against the module, filtering on date ranges, sources, indicator types, etc, or simply search for specific indicator values, and then export the results to a CSV file for use within your institution. To access the CIKR Threat Indicators module, go to ISAC Central, and select Quick Reference -View CIKR Threat Indicators. Instructions for filtering and searching the contents, and exporting the results to a CSV file are described in the CIKR Threat Indicators Module Release Notes, attached to this record on the portal.
