ISAC Analysis Team Updates

Google Chrome Zero-Day Exploit

Cybersecurity solutions provider, Edgespot, detected several PDF samples exploiting an unpatched Google Chrome. The exploit uses the “submitform” function. Given the analysis from Edgespot, collected information may include public IP address of the target system, operating system and Chrome version and the full path of the PDF file on the target system. Google has instructed users to update and check that their Chrome browser is version 72.0.3626.121 or later to patch the flaw. Visit the [Edgespot blog](#) or the [Google blog](#) for more details.

New Strain of Qbot Banking Malware

The security research team at Varonis Systems discovered a global campaign leveraging a new strain of Qbot (aka Qakbot) banking malware. The US, Europe, Asia and South America are current targets with the main goal of stealing financial information with most victim IP addresses having US origin. The new strain of Qbot is polymorphic and contains anti-analysis techniques to evade detection. It also utilizes several methods when exfiltrating financial data to the attacker’s server including keylogging, searching for credentials/cookies from browsers and API hooking.
